## **REFUGE REGULATIONS**

<u>GENERAL</u>	REFUGE REGULATIONS
PERMITTED	Hiking on designated trails outside hunting seasons-May 1 to September 30. Self-guided Auto Tour Route is open May 1 to September 30. See details at the Refuge Headquarters for more information.
PROHIBITED	Camping, snowmobiles, and fires. All motorized vehicles are prohibited except on designated roads.
<u>HUNTING</u>	Hunting is governed by State and Federal regulations. Only those species listed below are legal game. Waterfowl hunting is <b>NOT</b> permitted on the refuge.
UPLAND BIRDS	
Closed Area	Closed to all hunting-Headquarters area.
Area B	Open to Sharp-tail grouse and gray partridge during the state season. EXCEPTION: <b>Closed during rifle deer season.</b>
Area C	Open to Sharp-tail grouse and gray partridge only <b>AFTER</b> the close of rifle deer season.
DEER	
Area B and C	<b>Gun Hunting</b> Open to <b>gun</b> (Rifle and Muzzleloader) deer hunting during state seasons. Special refuge permit is not required. All other state permits and licenses required. Lostwood NWR is in the 3A1 zone as designated by North Dakota Game and Fish.
Area B and C	Archery Hunting Open to archery deer hunting from the beginning of state season to September 30. Reopens with the state season after the rifle deer season (Remains open during muzzleloader deer season).
Retrieving Deer	Unarmed friends and family members may help retrieve deer. Hunters may not carry a firearm while assisting others in the retrieval of deer, unless they possess an unfilled deer tag.
	All persons involved in retrieving deer must wear fluorescent orange clothing as required by State law for big-game hunting.
