SUBJECT: Designations of Funding for Overseas Contingency Operations/Global War on Terrorism

Section 6 of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2014, provides that the availability of funding contained in the Act that is designated by the Congress for Overseas Contingency Operations/Global War on Terrorism pursuant to section 251(b)(2)(A) of the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 (BBEDCA), as amended, is contingent upon the President subsequently so designating all such amounts and transmitting such designations to the Congress.

These funds for Overseas Contingency Operations/Global War on Terrorism fund the military and civilian costs necessary to achieve U.S. national security goals in Iraq, Afghanistan, Pakistan and other conflict areas. I recommend that you designate for Overseas Contingency Operations/Global War on Terrorism all funding (including the rescission of funds) so designated by the Congress in that Act pursuant to section 251(b)(2)(A) of BBEDCA, as outlined in the enclosed list of accounts. Upon transmittal of these designations to the Congress, these funds will be immediately available for obligation and expenditure or rescission, as appropriate. No further congressional action will be required.

These designations for Overseas Contingency Operations/Global War on Terrorism allow for adjustments to the discretionary spending limits in Fiscal Year 2014, as specified in section 251(b)(2)(A) of BBEDCA. These adjustments will be reflected when the Office of Management and Budget submits its final sequestration report under section 254(f) of BBEDCA.

I have carefully reviewed this proposed action and am satisfied it is necessary at this time. Therefore, I recommend that you make the requested funds available by signing the enclosed letters to the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President of the Senate.
