#### Explanation

The index lists the stream-flow and reservoir stations in the Missouri River Basin for which records have been collected and published (or are to be published) for periods prior to September 30, 1947. The stations on streams, canals, lakes, and reservoirs are listed in downstream order. Tributary streams are indicated by indentation. Of the stations in Canada only those for which records have been or soon will be published by the Geological Survey in water-supply papers have been included in the index.

Station names are given in their most recently published forms. Parentheses around part of a station name indicate that the inclosed word or words appeared in an earlier published name of the station or in a name under which records were published by some agency other than the Geological Survey. Brackets around part of a station name inclose a word or words that did not appear in the name under which some earlier records have been published, and the inclosed part of the name has been added later to the published name without superseding part of the earlier name. The name of a station on a reservoir has generally been extended to include the name of the stream on which the reservoir is located. If a reservoir is located offstream, that fact has been noted; and the name of the stream that is the major source of water for the reservoir has been given:

Discharge records for many stations on canals have been published only by state agencies, and the names of these canal stations usually have been extended to identify them more fully. For a canal diverting from a main stream, the name of the nearest town has usually been added to the name of the canal; for a canal diverting from a minor tributary, the words "diversion from" followed by the name of the tributary have usually been added to the name of the canal station. Canal wastes and small diversions from streams into well-known canals usually have been listed under the names of the canals, and the downstream order of these wastes and diversions has been assigned as though these wastes and diversions were tributaries of the canals.


An attempt has been made to list under one name all equivalent or nearly equivalent discharge records that were obtained at two or more nearby sites on a stream unless the equivalent records were obtained concurrently. Some records that were not approximately equivalent have teen published under one station name. These nonequivalent records have been separated in this index.

The drainage areas in square miles are the latest figures published or otherwise Evailable at this time. Drainage areas that obviously are inconsistent with other drainage areas on the same stream have been omitted. Some drainage areas not published by the Geological Survey are listed with an appropriate footnote stating the published source of the figure of drainage area.

Periods of records published or to be published by the Geological Survey are giver first. Breaks of less than one year in the periods of record have not been shown. Periods of records published by agencies other than the Geological Survey are listed in parentheses only when they contain more detailed information or are for periods not reported in publications of the Geological Survey. These listed periods of records published by other agencies show only the continuous periods of records of the type not wholly available in the periods of record listed ahead of it. A dash not followed immediately by a closing date shows that the station was in operation on September 30, 1947.

Records both of gage height and of discharge are listed for stream-flow stations, and records of gage height and of contents (or of change in contents) are listed for stations on reservoirs. Published records consisting only of infrequent discharge measurements are omitted from this index, although some of them were included in the index of September 30, 1947. A few short records of flow of small drains or of diversions or waste from canals have been omitted if they were published by State agencies only. Records of gage heights only and records consisting only of monthly figures either of stream flow or reservoir contents are designated by symbols and footnotes. For early years when daily discharges were not generally published by the Geological Survey, published daily gage heights and a published rating table were considered to be equivalent to daily discharges. Also hydrographs of daily discharge plus figures of monthly discharge were not noted as monthly figures only.

An alphabetical index of streams, canals, and reservoirs is given on pages 56 to 63.
