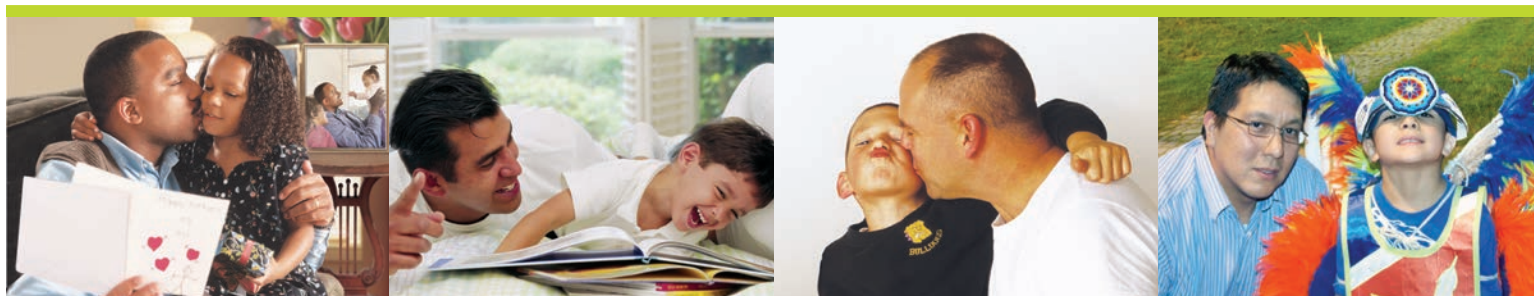
## **NRFC Activities**
