### REPORT

[To accompany H. R. 13040]

The Committee on Appropriations, to which was referred the bill (H. R. 13040) making appropriations to supply deficiencies in certain appropriations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1926, and prior fiscal years, to provide supplemental appropriations for the fiscal years ending June 30, 1926, and June 30, 1927, and for other purposes, reports the same to the Senate with various amendments, and presents herewith information relative to the changes made.
