RESOLUTION

OF THE

LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS,

ASKING

For the location of the Pacific Railroad on or near the 35th parallel of north latitude.

JANUARY 15, 1859.—Ordered to be printed.

Resolved by the general assembly of the State of Arkansas, That our senators be instructed, and our representatives in Congress be requested to vote for, and use all honorable means to secure the passage of a law locating the railroad to the Pacific on or near the 35th parallel of north latitude, upon or near the route surveyed by Lieutenant Whipple.
