SIR: I have the honor to transmit a "statement exhibiting, as far as practicable, the amount disbursed in each year, and in each State and Territory, from 1791 to 1833, inclusive, for fortifications, light-houses, public debt, revolutionary and other pensions, internal improvements, in-

cluding piers, breakwaters, &c., prepared in compliance with a resolution of the House of Representatives of the 23d ultimo.

The accounts for 1834 not being closed, or the repayments ascertained, the amount disbursed in that year in each State, and under the heads designated in the resolution, cannot be specifically stated. The total payments from the Treasury from the 1st January to the 30th September, 1834, were as follow :
