Mr. JOHN COCHRANE, from the Committee on Commerce, made the  
following

**REPORT.**

*The Committee on Commerce, to whom were referred a bill and several  
memorials for the creation of a collection district in the State of Texas,  
with a port of entry at Sabine Pass, submit the following report:*

That the purposes of the memorialists, so far as the conveniences  
of commerce are involved, can be obtained under the authority  
already conferred upon the Secretary of the Treasury, and the com-  
mittee, therefore, ask a discharge from the further consideration of  
the bill and memorials in question, and that the same be laid upon  
the table.
