

SPEAKER: In accordance with the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, I am transmitting the fiscal year 1984 budget supplemental of the District of Columbia. This supplemental proposes a net increase of \$9.3 million in the City's General Fund Budget and an increase of \$15 million in the Capital Projects Fund.

This increase is in District of Columbia funds and does not affect

the Federal Budget.
