#### Introduction:

This Draft Standard for Trial Use contains the format and establishes the data contents of the Contract Award Transaction Set (836) for use within the context of an Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) environment. The transaction set can be used by the buyer to notify the seller or other interested parties of the award of a contract which contains some indefinite features, such as delivery schedule, location, and/or quantities. This transaction set is intended to be the notification of the award of a requirements type of contract.

#### Notes:

- 1. Federal Agencies use this transaction set to announce the award of a contract or order. This notification will be publicly available to all interested parties and will provide the name of the party awarded the contract or order and the price of the line items. Item or service descriptions may be provided in the transaction set in order to assist in identifying subcontract opportunities.
- 2. Use a single occurrence of this transaction set to announce the award of one contract/order to a single vendor resulting from one or more solicitations.
